

DANGEROUS GOODS

If you have packed or are carrying any dangerous goods you must declare them when you check-in

FORBIDDEN

The Civil Aviation Safety Regulations forbids passengers to travel with most dangerous goods



Gas bottle



Car/motorbike battery



Flares, fire lighters, sparklers



Tasers



Petrol, diesel, fuel



Oil/enamel-based paint



Smart bags
(non-removable batteries over 0.3g or 2.7Wh)



Mace, pepper spray

SOME DANGEROUS GOODS ARE PERMITTED PROVIDED CERTAIN CARRIAGE REQUIREMENTS ARE MET

Must be declared with check-in staff for restrictions



Ammunition



Aerosols, CO2 gas cartridges



Camping stoves



Mobility aids



Life jackets (self-inflating)



Batteries (spare) /Powerbanks



Magnetised materials



Power tools



Heat producing devices



Engines (internal combustion)



Dry ice



Oxygen (for medical use)

Do you have any e-cigarettes in your bag?



Do you have a smart bag with a power bank fitted?



Are you carrying fuel cells containing fuel, powering portable electronic devices (e.g camera, cellular phones, laptop computers, camcorder)
