JUNIOR CREATIVES BOARDING PASS DESIGN COMPETITION

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1. Promoter and Competition

1. The promoter of the Nexus Airlines Junior Creatives Boarding Pass Design competition (**Competition**) is Aviair Pty Ltd (ABN 94 009 145 055) trading as Nexus Airlines (referred to in these Terms and Conditions as **Nexus Airlines**).
2. The Competition invites children to design original artwork for new Nexus Airlines boarding passes, inspired by the themes of flying, travel, adventure and regional Western Australia.
3. The Competition will be conducted in accordance with the following schedule (**Competition Schedule**):

Entries open	12:01am (AWST) on Wednesday, 12 August 2026
Entries close	11:59pm (AWST) on Wednesday, 9 September 2026
Winner and Featured Entries announced	Friday, 11 September 2026

2. Eligibility

4. Entry is open to children aged between four (4) and twelve (12) years at the date of entry who are Western Australian residents (**Child Entrants**).
5. A Child Entrant may only participate with the consent of their parent or legal guardian aged 18 years or over (**Parent/Guardian**).
6. Entry to the Competition is not open to children of employees of Nexus Airlines.
7. Each Child Entrant may submit only one (1) entry into the Competition.

3. How to Enter

8. Each entry must be submitted by the Parent/Guardian through the Nexus Airlines website.
9. Nexus Airlines may reject or disqualify any entry where valid consent cannot be verified.
10. Each entry must:
 - a. be the Child Entrant's own, original artwork, created by the Child Entrant;
 - b. be inspired by the themes of flying, travel, adventure and/or regional Western Australia;
 - c. comply with any guidelines published on the entry landing page from time to time; and

- d. not contain any material that is unlawful, defamatory, obscene, offensive, or that infringes the intellectual property or privacy rights of any third party.
- 11. Artwork may be created in any medium. Physical artwork must be photographed or scanned and submitted online via the Nexus Airlines website. Posted or hard-copy entries will not be accepted.
- 12. Nexus Airlines may reject an entry that does not meet these requirements.
- 13. Entries must be received between the entries open and entries close dates set out in the Competition Schedule. Late entries will not be accepted.

4. Prizes

- 14. Entries will be judged by a panel of up to three (3) Nexus Airlines employees (**Judges**) based on creativity and relevance to the theme.
- 15. The Judges will select:
 - a. one (1) winning entry, who will receive one (1) \$1,000 Nexus Airlines flight voucher and a Nexus Airlines Gift Pack (**the Winning Entry**); and
 - b. up to five (5) further entries which will each receive a Nexus Airlines Gift Pack (**the Featured Entries**).
- 16. The artwork of each Winning Entry and Featured Entry will be reproduced on Nexus Airlines boarding passes for a period of up to eighteen (18) months, commencing on or about 1 October 2026.
- 17. The Judges' decision is final, subject to any rights that cannot be excluded by law.
- 18. If there are insufficient suitable entries, Nexus Airlines may select fewer Featured Entries.
- 19. Nexus Airlines will notify the Parent/Guardian of each Winning Entry and Featured Entry by email or phone.
- 20. Nexus Airlines is not responsible for prizes that cannot be delivered due to an incorrect or inactive email address provided with the entry.
- 21. The Nexus Airline Flight Voucher is valid for travel for twelve (12) months from the date of issue and may be redeemed on any scheduled Nexus Airlines service, subject to availability and Nexus Airlines' Conditions of Carriage.
- 22. All prizes must be taken as stated and are not redeemable for cash.
- 23. If the Winning Entry or a Featured Entry is disqualified under these Terms and Conditions, the corresponding prize is forfeited and Nexus Airlines is not required to award it to an alternative recipient.

6. Artwork, Intellectual Property and Consents

- 24. The Child Entrant retains ownership and copyright of their artwork.
- 25. By consenting to a Child Entrant's participation in the Competition, the Parent/Guardian grants, on behalf of the Child Entrant, Nexus Airlines a non-exclusive, royalty-free licence to

use, reproduce, resize, crop, format and publish the Child Entrant's entry for the purposes of conducting and promoting the Competition, including on Nexus Airlines' website and social media. For a Winning Entry and Featured Entry, this licence also covers reproducing the artwork on Nexus Airlines boarding passes for the eighteen (18) month display period. Nexus Airlines may retain an archival copy after that period but must not use it for new promotional purposes without the Parent/Guardian's consent.

- 26. No fee, royalty or other payment is payable beyond the prizes described in these Terms and Conditions.
- 27. When publicly identifying a Child Entrant, Nexus Airlines will use only the Child Entrant's first name, age and school (if applicable) unless the Parent/Guardian separately consents to additional information being published.
- 28. The Parent/Guardian warrants that they are authorized to grant the licence in clause 25 on behalf of the Child Entrant.

7. Privacy

- 29. Nexus Airlines collects the Parent/Guardian's contact details and limited information about the Child Entrant to administer the Competition, judge entries, notify selected entrants, award prizes and use Featured Entries as described above. If the required information is not provided, the entry cannot be accepted.
- 30. Nexus Airlines may disclose this information to its contractors where reasonably required to administer the Competition or produce boarding passes and promotional material.
- 31. Nexus Airlines will handle personal information in accordance with the Privacy Act 1988 (Cth) and its [Privacy Policy](#).
- 32. Any consent to receive marketing communications is optional and is not required to enter the Competition.
- 33. A Parent/Guardian may request access to or correction of their or the Child Entrant's personal information by contacting marketing@nexusairlines.com.au.
- 34. If the Competition is promoted via social media, to the extent required by the applicable platform's terms of use, those terms will apply to any aspect of the Competition conducted on that platform. Participants acknowledge the Competition is in no way sponsored, endorsed or administered by any social media platform.

8. Liability

- 35. Nothing in these Terms and Conditions excludes, restricts or modifies any rights or remedies that cannot lawfully be excluded, including under the Australian Consumer Law (Schedule 2 of the Competition and Consumer Act 2010 (Cth)).
- 36. To the extent permitted by law, Nexus Airlines' liability arising directly from the Competition or Prize is limited to the resupply of the relevant prize (or a reasonably equivalent substitute).
- 37. Nexus Airlines' liability in respect of any flight comprised in the Winning Prize is as described in its Conditions of Carriage and is subject to the Civil Aviation (Carrier's Liability) Act 1959 (Cth).

38. Subject to the above, Nexus Airlines (including its officers, employees, contractors and agents) excludes all liability for any loss, damage (including indirect, special or consequential loss or damage) or personal injury arising from or in connection with the Competition or any prize.

9. General

39. Nexus Airlines may disqualify an entry (including the Winning Entry or a Featured Entry) if it reasonably considers that the entry breaches these Terms and Conditions or is misleading, fraudulent or not submitted in good faith.
40. Nexus Airlines reserves the right to amend, suspend or cancel the Competition (or any part of it) at any time in its absolute discretion, subject to any applicable law.
41. By consenting to a Child Entrant's participation in the Competition, the Parent/Guardian agrees to these Terms and Conditions, on their own behalf and on behalf of the Child Entrant.
42. These Terms and Conditions are governed by the laws of Western Australia.
